Cost

Market Open Interest (MOI) is available to purchase from the LME for \$400 per contract per year. This data is only available at the end of each calendar year. For example 2016 MOI prices will be available for purchase from January 2017.

Delivery

Data will be supplied in MS Excel (CSV) format by email once payment by credit card or bank transfer has been received.

Description

Market Open Interest (MOI) is a calculation produced by the LME's Compliance Department that represents the open interest of both LME clearing members and non-clearing members and their clients for each metal on each prompt date (and, in the case of TAPOs and options, strike price). These prices indicate the liquidity and depth of each market.

MOI prices are published daily two business days in arrears and calculated from the open positions reported to the LME by members. An explanation of how these calculations are made is set out in LME Notice 98/090: R006, issued on 12 March 1998. Please contact the LME compliance department for additional information.

Please be aware that:

- Steel contracts were launched in February 2008, and then became one global contract in July 2010. (Data for Steel is only available in USD)
- The Minor Metal contracts were launched in February 2010.
- Plastics were listed contracts between 2005 and 2010. The Polypropylene and Linear Low-density Polyethylene contracts launched in May 2005, while the 3 regional contracts for both plastics were launched in June 2007.
- MOI is provided as one file with all contract types per month for Aluminium, Copper, Zinc, Lead, NASAAC and Nickel. For the remainder of the LME metals, data is provided in one file per year.
- Steel Rebar and Steel Scrap were launched in November 2015.
