Subject: PORT OF NORFOLK – LAPSE OF DELIVERY POINT STATUS

## Summary

1. This notice advises that the approval of the Port of Norfolk as a Delivery Point has now lapsed.

## Details

2. The LME's Policy on the Approval of Locations as Delivery Points (the "Policy") states that in the event that a Warehouse has not been approved for a Delivery Point within six months of the LME's approval of that Delivery Point, the LME's approval of that Delivery Point shall lapse.
3. The Port of Norfolk, which was approved as a Delivery Point for primary aluminium, NASAAC, copper, lead, nickel, tin and zinc (see Notice 18/180), does not have any approved Warehouses and therefore the LME's approval of the Port of Norfolk as a Delivery Point has now lapsed. The LME will therefore no longer consider any applications for Warehouses to be listed in Norfolk.
